101	Ke Bonta Cortese, Piemonte, Italy 11% alc Vg A great alternative to Gavi. This is a fresh, crisp and dry white with green apple aromas and fresh notes of grapefruit, lime and honeysuckle. The palate is slightly honeyed, yet fresh and crisp with citrus flavours, almond notes, and minerality on the finish. We love this for summer drinking, as an aperitif or just for a good time!	5	7.5 / 26
102	Portal de Calcada 'Patusco', Vinho Verde, Portugal 11% alc Vg A classic, light, and zesty Vinho Verde that pours a pale citrus-yellow. It carries a playful 'wee spritz' that lifts the fresh lemon and green orchard fruit aromas. 103	Origini Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie, Italy 11.5% alc Vg This is a proper, well-made Pinot Grigio that showcases the characteristic freshness and elegance of the region rather than being just another bland pour. You will find lively aromas of freshly cut pear and white stone fruit, followed by a bright, medium-bodied palate. Notes of ripe pear and a touch of sherbet are perfectly balanced by a clean almond finish.	5.1	7.6 / 27
104	Esprit de Vignes, Piquepoul, Cotes de Thau, France 12.5% alc Vg This is a delicious Piquepoul from the Cotes de Thau that is low in sulphites. The maritime influences give the grapes a very refreshing acidity which translates in the wine along with a lovely minerality. This is a ripe zesty wine, with citrus, apple and floral aroma and a juicy white peach flavour and a lightly saline finish. A firm favourite.		34
105	Domaine de la Motte Chablis, Burgundy, France 13% alc We consider this a true classic, crafted by a previous winner of the French White Winemaker of the Year award. It delivers a reliable expression of Chablis accompanied by generous stone fruit aromatics and a distinctly chalky, mineral nose. The palate is complex with ripe fruits, finishing with a satisfying hint of nuttiness that reminds us why Burgundy commands such respect.		45

106	Les Sardines, Chardonnay, Vin de France 12% alc Vg If you think you don't like Chardonnay, this refreshing, full-flavoured, and entirely unoaked wine might just change your mind. It focuses purely on enticing aromas of white peach layered with mineral tones of crushed stone. A subtle hint of spice adds depth to a beautifully textured mouthfeel and a lasting finish.	5.1	7.6 / 27
107	El Coto, Rioja Blanco, Spain 12% alc A lovely, dry, unoaked white Rioja expertly blending Viura, Verdejo, and Sauvignon Blanc grapes. It presents an intensely fruity nose, while remaining clean and light on the palate. We view this as a very classy wine indeed, opening with crystal-clear notes of citrus, white stone fruits, and delicate florality. It boasts the crisp, beautifully structured texture that is the hallmark of fine Albariño. There is a clean, lingering finish that refreshes and satisfies in equal measure.

113 Frank, Chenin Blanc, Coastal Region, South Africa 13% alc Vg

Sourced from old vines in Paarl this aromatic Chenin Blanc is made using the free-run juice for fermentation, then left on the lees for two months before bottling. On the nose an attractive abundance of ripe pear, quince and spring blossom. The palate is rich and rounded with a delicate mouthfeel, crisp citrus and apple flavours linger on a very smooth finish.

114 Boccantino Fiano Appassito, Puglia, Italy 13% alc

Crafted using the appassito method to concentrate flavours, this straw-yellow Fiano offers elegant aromas of fruit, almonds, and tropical notes. It is a medium to full-bodied white, remaining fresh and harmonic on the palate. We think this is a deliciously rich and unctuous wine, in a good way, with a long and pleasant finish.

115 Domaine Dupre, Bourgogne, France 12.5% alc Vg

This rich and beautifully balanced white Burgundy pours a luminous gold colour that hints at its complexity. Fresh white-fleshed fruit aromas emerge on the nose, complemented by subtle oak, vanilla, and roasted hazelnut undertones. The palate reveals a medium-bodied wine with remarkable elegance, liveliness, and a highly refined texture that shows real winemaking skill.

201 Portraits of America LA Zin, White Zinfandel, California, USA 9.5% alc Vg

Selected from old-vine vineyards in central California, the grapes are lightly crushed to create a pretty pink wine. It boasts luscious aromas of strawberry ice cream, supported by a bright, berry-fruited palate. The finish is off-dry and exquisitely easy-drinking for those who prefer a gentler style.

202 Portal da Calçada Rosé, Vinho Verde, Portugal 11.5% alc Vg

A beautiful, bright salmon-pink rosé expressing the true character of Vinho Verde. It features subtle red fruit notes in an easy-drinking, light, and dry style. Clean and refreshing, it is a perfect uncomplicated pour that we find ourselves returning to often.

203 Tramari, Rosé de Primitivo, Salento, Italy 12.5% Vg

A delicate coral-pink wine from Puglia made with 100% Primitivo, bursting with red berry, citrus, and Mediterranean herb notes. It wafts delicate aromas of wild strawberry, pomegranate, and pink grapefruit joined by hints of rose and fresh basil. The palate is crisp and refreshing, balancing redcurrant and sour cherry flavours with a subtle saline edge.

204 Whispering Angel, Côtes de Provence Rosé, France 13% alc Vg

This is a beautifully pale pink rosé offering a perfumed bouquet of elegant summer fruits. Made from a blend of old vines and using traditional Burgundian winemaking techniques, it possesses unusual complexity for a Provence rosé. The refined palate balances faint cherry notes with beautifully integrated acidity, living up to its strong reputation.

ORANGE

skin contact & amber win

So, what’s all the fuss about orange wines and why are they having a moment?

Orange wine, also known as skin-contact wine or amber wine- in a nutshell, this is a white wine made exactly like a red wine. While conventional white wine is pressed and separated from its skins immediately, orange wine ferments with the grape skins and seeds still attached for days or months. This skin contact extracts a deep orange hue, bold flavours, and tannins. Because it has tannins and a robust texture similar to a red wine, but the acidity, citrus, and floral notes of a white wine, it offers a distinct drinking experience.

Flavour Profile: Notes of dried fruit, bruised apple, honey, nuts, and sometimes a slightly sour or “funky” character.

Texture: You will feel a drying, grippy sensation (tannins) on your tongue, similar to drinking black tea.

Though incredibly popular on modern natural wine lists, this is actually an ancient winemaking technique originating roughly 8,000 years ago in the country of Georgia, where producers fermented grapes in large, beeswax-lined clay vessels buried underground called qvevri.

Not for everyone, but definitely worth a try and a great wine style to match most food dishes.

205 Luis Felipe Edwards, Macerao, Semillon Orange, 6 / 9 / 33

Valle de Conchagua, Chile 13% alc Vg

Crafted using artisanal winemaking methods, this is an immediately accessible and delicious orange wine that we often use to introduce people to the style. Ripe peach flavours sit perfectly alongside floral and spicy notes. It is complemented by a fantastic texture, delicate tannins, and refreshing acidity.

206 Regarde d’Artiste, Vin Orange 6.5 / 9.7 / 35

Herault,Languedoc-Roussillon, France 12% alc Vg

One of the most approachable styles of orange wine we have tasted, this is a unique southern French blend of Muscat, Grenache Blanc, and Viognier in equal measures. The grapes undergo skin contact in concrete vats for one week to extract flavour. This yields intense aromas of bitter oranges, dried flowers, and nutty hints that conclude with a long, elegant, and well-balanced finish.

207 Teliani Valley Kakhuri No8, Amber Dry Wine 7 / 10.5 / 38

Kakheti, Georgia 12.5% alc Vg

From Teliani’s more experimental ‘Winery 97’ project, this amber wine blends four grape varieties that are quite difficult to pronounce: Rkatsiteli, Kakhuri, Khikhvi, and Kisi. It is made using an ancient winemaking technique originating roughly 8,000 years ago in Georgia, where grapes ferment with their skins in underground clay vessels called qvevri. It delivers rich dried fruit and nutty flavours, alongside a long, dry, refreshing finish that is much easier to wrap your head around. We find this a distinct drinking experience that lets the flavours shine beautifully over the robust, tea-like tannins.

In this light and simple blend, the soft blackberry fruit of the Merlot blends harmoniously with the characteristic red cherry character of the Corvina. This wine is fresh, bright, and well-balanced. We always say that creating something this drinkable and uncomplicated is the true sign of a well-made wine.

- Bazar Pinot Noir Gewurztraminer, IGP Pays d’Oc, France 13% alc Vg

We didn’t think this would work either, but red cherry notes from the Pinot Noir meet with lychee and tropical fruit from the Gewurztraminer to brilliant effect. The resulting flavour is charming, juicy, and beautifully aromatic. With its refreshing acidity, this is an uplifting red and a firm new favourite amongst our team.

- The Notes, Gamay, Vin de France 12% alc Vg

Showcasing the pure typicity of the Beaujolais grape, Gamay, this is a light and refreshing wine with a crunchy, fruit-forward taste. Its cherry colour and aroma of red fruits make it a genuinely great all-rounder with cheese, charcuterie or simply on it’s own. It has a balanced structure that is light in body yet full on flavour.

- The Impressionist, Pinot Noir, North Macedonia 12% alc Vg

This is a pale ruby red in colour with a soft nose of redcurrants and red cherries. The palate is very smooth with a core of red fruit flavours and sweet spices supported by supple tannins giving structure. The finish is long and smooth, with the red cherry and raspberry notes lingering nicely in the glass. Great with cheese. Or without!

Hailing from Georgia, recognized as the historical cradle of wine production, this deeply coloured red is warm and spicy. It offers vibrant aromas of wild berries and red plum. Smooth on the palate with soft tannins and a well-balanced hint of spice, it is a very enjoyable pour. This is a new favourite with the staff at our sister company Aitken’s.

306 Oxte Cézanne Garnacha, Cariñena, Spain 13% alc Vg6.1 / 9.1 / 34

Garnacha (aka Grenache) at its finest, displaying a bold purple colour and aromas of red berries with a hint of black fruit. Notes of cherry, raspberry, and plum are complemented by subtle spice—the result of three months of aging on the lees. The wine is both soft and bold, balanced by great acidity, making it ideal for drinking before a meal or with a selection of tapas dishes. This is a new favourite with the staff at our sister company Aitken’s. .

307 Valdepalacios Rioja Crianza, Spain 14% alc Vg6.7 / 9.9 / 36

This is proper ‘old school’ Rioja. An exciting arrival from Bodegas Leza García. A blend of 85% Tempranillo, 10% Garnacha, and 5% Mazuelo, aged for 12 months in oak barrels and 6 months in the bottle. It delivers an intense, complex aroma where fruit and oak complement each other beautifully, backed by ripe, smooth tannins.

308 Palo Santo Cabernet Franc, Valle de Uco, Argentina 13.5% alc38

This beautiful wine opens with a nose of goji berry, pencil shavings and tomato plant. On the palate it’s juicy, structured and bright, with texture and a gently grippy finish characteristic. Bright red in colour, with aromas of bell pepper and red fruits typical of Cabernet Franc. Subtle spicy notes from oak ageing add complexity. The palate confirms the aromatic promise of the nose, delivering good acidity and a balanced, elegant finish.

309 Jim Barry Watervale Shiraz, Clare Valley, Australia 14% alc39

A fresher, more vibrant expression of Clare Valley Shiraz that bursts with blue and black fruits, black pepper, and subtle violets. The juicy, energetic palate is packed with blackberry and plum, supported by gentle tannins and minimal oak that lets the fruit shine. This is a big, bold, unapologetically Aussie red that finishes fresh and lively with impressive detail.

310 I Buongiorno, Susumaniello, Salento, Puglia, Italy 14% alc Vg O42

Crafted by a boutique winery project founded by acclaimed sommelier and restaurateur Teodosio Buongiorno, this wine captures Salento’s sun-drenched essence. Pouring a deep purplish ruby, it offers aromatic notes of ripe berries and plum jam. The complex palate nicely balances up-front fruit with spice, black pepper, and licorice. It is juicy, delicious, and definitely worth a try if you are looking to branch out.

ROUND & FULL robust body, rich textures, and bold flavour profiles

311	Kaiken, Malbec Clásico, Mendoza, Argentina	13.5% alc Vg	6 / 9 / 33
	Fruity aromas intermingle with wildflowers and blackberries in this full and delicious red that always delivers. Oak aging contributes inviting secondary notes of coffee and chocolate. The palate is smooth, featuring well-balanced acidity, round tannins, and an elegant, velvety finish.		
312	I Muri, Primitivo, Puglia, Italy	14.5% alc Vg	6.2 / 9.3 / 35
	From the heel of Italy, this Primitivo (aka Zinfandel) has red berry fruit perfumes with a hint of spice. Full-bodied with firm tannins, this wine is well balanced with lots of ripe fruit flavours. A dark, lush and velvety red from the heel of Italy. A longstanding favourite both here and at our sister business Aitken Wines. Taste the sunshine!		
313	Linton Park, Merlot, Western Cape, South Africa	14.5% alc Vg	36
	A big, robust, and classy red offering aromas of black and red berry fruit with secondary notes of chocolate and spices. The aging process imparts a subtle, savoury hint of olive grove. Rounded, soft, and rich, the palate is elegant and well-balanced with a luxuriously smooth and layered finish.		
314	Château Laurence 'Petite Laurence' Bordeaux Supérieur, France	14.5% alc	42
	A very special, old-school Claret boasting a fully expressive aroma of mellowed red fruits and soft floral touches. It is soft, smooth, and gentle, providing what we like to call a big warm hug of a red wine. A savoury woody undertone and just the right amount of grip make it a wonderfully classic pour.		
315	Montresor, 'Satinato' Amarone della Valpolicella, Italy	15% alc Vg	65
	We think this is a truly wonderful example of an Italian great, opening with hints of coffee and chocolate on the nose. The palate is rich and warming, delivering ripe crushed berry, bitter cherry, and sweet plummy fruit backed by notes of bitter chocolate. Despite its concentration, it remains fresh and well-balanced with supple tannins and a rich texture.		

SPARKLING WINES

401	Fresita, Strawberry Sparkling Wine, Chile	8% alc Vg	6.5 / 33
	This premium Chilean sparkling wine is infused with handpicked fresh strawberries for a naturally fruity profile. It features lovely berry fruit flavours with an off-dry to medium sweetness. We find it wonderfully uncomplicated, fun, and just a great drink to enjoy when relaxing with or without friends!		
402	Di Maria, Prosecco Spumante, Famiglia Botter Veneto, Italy	10.5% alc Vg	7 / 35
	Sourced from one of Italy's finest Prosecco producers, Famiglia Botter, this is a clean and brilliant example of the style. It is fine, fresh, and delicately fruity, offering aromas of green apples and pears. The light body and aromatic finish are nicely balanced, making it highly drinkable and very hard to fault.		
403	Vallformosa, Cava Brut NV, Spain	11.5% alc Vg	7 / 35
	This lovely bubbly is an approachable and dryer style sparkling wine that evokes aromas of ripe apple and brioche. Its palate displays delightful orchard fruit characters and a balanced acidity, complemented by a persistent mousse. With its delightful flavour, this Cava makes a perfect accompaniment for starters, small plates and tapas.		
404	Santa Tresa Il Frappato Spumante Brut, Sicily	12% alc VgO	8 / 39
	Another new favourite here at TWP. Showcasing a beautiful salmon-pink color, this sparkling Frappato offers fine, gentle bubbles and a very fresh, fruity nose accented by wild strawberries. Very well-balanced and soft on the palate with a clean, refreshing acidity. The perfect pink fizz for any celebration and, like a lot of Sicilian wines, this one's organic.		
405	Cave de Turckheim Crémant d'Alsace Tradition Brut, France	12% alc Vg	8.2 / 40
	A richer, more complex kind of fizz that is beautifully crafted, expressive, and lively. It carries aromas of baked apples alongside bright, fresh acidity. With slightly less pressure than a traditional Champagne, the bubbles create a soft, rounded texture that makes it exceptionally moreish.		
406	Saint Clair, Pét Nat, Marlborough, New Zealand	12% alc Vg	45
	Pét Nat, short for pétillant naturel (French for "naturally sparkling"), is a naturally fizzy wine made using the ancient méthode ancestrale. Winemakers bottle the wine before its first fermentation is fully finished, trapping the remaining carbon dioxide to create light, lively bubbles. This is a delightfully crisp and refreshing gently sparkling wine, with layered notes of fresh green apple, white stone fruits, a delicate hint of citrus and elegant lees influence		
407	Sacchetto, Mille Bolle, Alcohol Free Sparkling wine	0% alc Vg	5 / 22
	This is what we call a 'grown up' soft drink! A refreshing, alcohol-free sparkling wine, with delicious notes of apricot and peach complemented by delicate floral overtones. Vibrant and fresh, with lovely balance and a lively, uplifting finish.		

CHAMPAGNES

So, what makes Champagne so special?

Champagne is special because of its strict origin laws, the rigorous méthode champenoise (a secondary fermentation in the bottle that creates fine bubbles and complex, toasty flavours), and, let’s be honest, centuries of brilliant marketing that linked the sparkling wine to royalty, luxury, and major life celebrations. In our humble opinion, and despite competition for quality sparklers from all over the world including some of the above, we still think it’s the best fizz out there and here are just a few to tempt the tastebuds!
