- 109 Piqueras, Wild fermented Verdejo 2019, Almansa, Spain 13% alc 25
The Verdejo grapes are sourced from the coolest, high altitude vines and harvested at night to preserve the fruit, freshness and aromatics. Wild yeasts start the ferment, and the wine is aged for just two months in French oak. Unctuous on the palate with great natural acidity. A full bodied and delicious white.
- 110 Fritz Willi Riesling 2019/20, Mosel, Germany 11% alc 28
Fragrant aromas of ripe apricots, citrus and apple. Minerality and ripe, rounded stone fruit flavours are balanced by zesty lemon sherbert characters - giving an appealing off-dry style which retains a surprisingly crisp finish.
- 111 Vigneti Radica, Pecorino 2019, Terre di Chieti, Italy 13% alc 29
A straw yellow wine with green highlights, fruity, with citrus and tropical nuances and a delicate notes of flowers. well-bodied, good structure with slightly mineral notes. Just lovely, with or without food.
- 112 Martin Códax, Albariño 2019, Rías Baixas, Spain 12%alc 30
Fresh passionfruit, pear and citrus aromas rise from the glass. Zesty on the palate, with good flavour intensity and great freshness on the long finish – crisp, refreshing with a balanced acidity.
- 113 Kloof Street, Old Vine Chenin Blanc 2020, Swartland, South Africa 13% alc 33
This fuller bodied white shows aromas of sun-ripened pears and wet granite on the nose. The palate has a vibrant acidity balanced by a soft, round texture and some pithy character. The wine has a fresh, mineral finish and a real depth of flavours enhanced with oak.
114. Ranch 32, Chardonnay 2017/18, Monterey, USA 13.5% alc 36
The nose delivers yellow apple, citrus, and tropical fruit, with a touch of caramel and toasted vanilla bean. The palate is rich and concentrated with notes of bright fruit, butterscotch and minerals. A beautifully balanced white with true vibrancy.
- 115 Joëlle Vrignaud, Les Champréaux, Chablis 2017, France 12.5%alc 45
This wine is golden yellow in colour. The nose marries citrus and floral notes with vanilla nuances derived from the oak ageing. The palate is rich and intense, balanced by a refreshing acidity and ending with a long and complex finish.

This is followed on the palate with notes of apricot, fig, dates and ripe raisins and wonderfully suggestive flavours of warm patisserie, vanilla touches with hints of caramel and ginger, and a spicy finish with hints of rosewood.
